Over the past couple of decades the demise of the paper book has been predicted many times. I remember that it was going to be the floppy disk, the CD-ROM, Online access or the eBook that was going to drive the final nail in the coffin of the printed word. So far none of these have succeeded and, although Online Access and eBooks have their place, it seems that the book will still be around for a while yet. However, the one format that I believe has finally had its day is the CD-ROM.



The CD-ROM has always been a popular upgrade to Sweet & Maxwell's key annual titles and it was a great addition to these books. It meant there was no need to take the books home with you at the weekend as you could just keep the CD in your laptop. However, technology has moved on now and with the new edition of the **White Book** due later this month and I would like to extol the virtues of the eBook over the CD-ROM.

Why the White Book ProView eBook is better than the CD

With ProView you can annotate, bookmark and highlight text. This text will then synch through to other copies of the book that you may have on other devices. Annotations from previous editions can be carried through to the current edition if so required. On the CD you can only highlight and tag.

The search function is much smoother and the Contents page is far more intuitive. Navigation around the White Book is smooth and intuitive.

The CD was never compatible with Macs - the eBook is.

A lot of devices no longer have a CD drive.

You can lose a CD but you can't lose an eBook. Even if you break your iPad or PC the eBook, with your annotations, will still be stored in the cloud. Old editions will also be stored with the ProView App for you to refer to.

The net price of the 2 Volume book & eBook is £730. The net price of the book & CD is £745.

What the CD offer that the eBook doesn't

The CD does contain the Forms and a few extra Rules and Procedures that were taken out of the book and eBook a few years ago. However these are all available online for free via the White Book updating service. The Forms CD is also available as a separate upgrade for just $\pm 10 + VAT$.

The Old Munster Circuit, the legal memoirs of Maurice Healy, was first published in 1939 by Michael Joseph, and has reappeared in several editions over the last 75 years. It has been out of print in recent times and much sought after. These amusing memoirs affectionately describe the workings and people of the Munster Circuit, where Healy practised from 1910 to 1914. Healy goes to some length in trying to describe and explain his countrymen to an English audience:

"The difference of atmosphere between the two countries was exemplified in a case of my father's which came to be tried in London before Mr Justice Darling. The point at issue was the identity of a valuable picture, and hosts of witnesses, many of them humble Irish folk, were examined on either side. One of these Irishmen who had tuned his harp to the romantic air of his own County Court was a shock to a judge of pedestrian imagination. Darling at last turned to him sternly and said 'Tell me, in your country, what happens to a witness who does not tell the truth?' 'Begor, me Lord,' replied the Irishman, with a candour that disarmed all criticism, 'I think his side usually wins.'"







This study offers the reader an in-depth analysis of the role of law in China's impressive post-Mao economic transformation, contextualizing the Chinese experience in law and development theory and its application to China. The book makes a substantial contribution to discourses on the very important issue of the nature of the Chinese land system in the transformation from state-planning to the market. It is an on-going debate as to whether demarcated and secure property rights are essential for sustainable economic development. In addition, land is an extremely important issue in China, especially in terms of the role of state and the manner in which the state is dealing with land ownership and other rights in times of change. The book examines the hybrid dynamic of Chinese land law, the multi-layered stakeholders involved, and the varied and divergent incentives for exploiting land. The evolution of mainland China's land system has been shaped by various political and social forces, and the book highlights key aspects of the nature of the law and how complicated the law in action can be in transitional socio-economic systems such as that of China. She has been a research associate and postdoctoral fellow at the School of Law, CityU Hong Kong. She at present teaches Jurisprudence, Law and Development, Sociology of Law and Land Law at Shantou University.



China has become the first socialist legal system to acquire an interest and the capacity to invest significantly beyond its own borders and abandon the policies of economic autarchy that approaches to socialist economic planning seemed to impose upon predecessor socialist legal systems. In this pathbreaking study, Dr. Chenyang XIE examines how the Chinese legal system regulates – usually by default rather than design – Chinese investor behavior with respect to outward investment opportunities and/or priorities. He offers intelligent and perceptive critiques of legal rules, institutions, systems, and administrative practices, providing suggestions for potential reform or adjustments of these.

Drawing upon the Chinese tradition of codification, the author has prepared a draft Code of Overseas Investment Law, together with Commentary to explain why each formulation is desirable and necessary. In his view, Chinese overseas investment relations are a "legal laboratory" for shaping a constructive legal regime to encourage and regulate such investment. His bold, subtle, and nuanced strategy embodies reservations about the extent to which in a planned economy the State should assume investment risks rather than the non-State sector.

Subjects covered include the Chinese macro policies and concepts of overseas investment, information services, investment promotion, approvals, authorizations, and filings, financial support, foreign exchange regulation, insurance, taxation, and supervision Stateowned assets abroad. The draft Code of Overseas Investment Law is the first of its kind for any legal system.

Chenyang XIE received his LL.M. and S.J.D. degrees at the Pennsylvania State University. He has many years of experience with legal aspects of inward and outward Chinese investment flows as a senior legal advisor employed by The Tiens Group in China.
